MAJOR REQUIREMENTS (Total Credits: 76-80)

Acceptance into major: New freshmen, also, transfer students and students from other USU majors who have at least a **2.75 overall gpa**, qualify to enter the Kinesiology: Physical Education Teaching major. Please note, in order to be accepted into the STEP program students must have an overall gpa of 3.0. All major content coursework (KIN) requires a grade of C or better.
